Who can attend?

Good News Club is open to all boys and girls between the ages of five and twelve, regardless of religious background.

State Law ORS 339-420 acknowledges the right of parents to have their children released for religious education class if they so choose. There is a *Good News Club* available at nearly every public elementary school and a growing number of middle schools in Central Oregon. The program is not tax supported, nor does the school or school district necessarily endorse the program.

Who teaches *Good News Club*?

The club is taught by trained volunteers with good reputations in your community who care for children.



Where does the *Good News Club* meet?

Club members meet their GNC teacher and/or helper at the school and walk with them to and from the club meeting place, which is in a church, home or *Good News Club* trailer near the school.

Does it cost anything?

No, there is no cost. You do not have to be a member of a church to come. Join today and begin classes immediately.

How can I start attending?

Your parent or guardian must complete and sign the registration form for you to attend. Bring the signed registration form from this brochure to the school office. The school secretary can tell you the day and time of the club or you can call the local CEF Chapter for more information.
